This is our newest swimming pool, and located in a residential area. It is 10 metres long, and has both a shallow and deep end. Ideal for learning how to swim in all depths. One to One Lesson - 6 Week Course - £265.00 or £45 for one off lesson.

Two to One Lesson - 6 Week Course - £175 per child or £30 per child for one off lesson.

Three to One Lesson - 6 Week Course - £149.00 per child or £26 per child for one off lesson.
